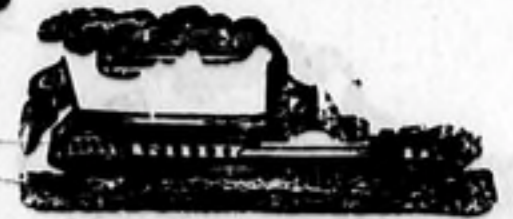

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Oliver Anglin of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the
St Joseph of Buffalo whereof Jacob Senf is
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y.
in the year 1841 as appears by No. Enrollment

dated at this Port the Twentieth day of May 1846 numbered 126,

mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller _____ has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
