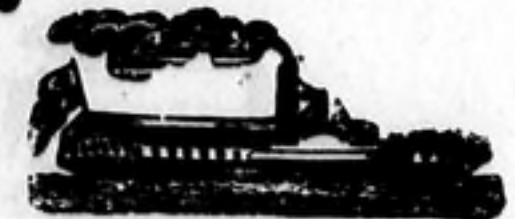


# ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Thomas P. Folger of Buffalo & Co. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Charles J. Folger of Seneca St. John R. of Buffalo and Rowland P. Church of this City.

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the "Hope" of Buffalo whereof Rowland P. Church is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by the certificate of

B. B. Jones Master builded, dated 29th day of April 1847. Now on file in this Office

And William J. Mearns having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is One hundred & twenty four feet four & one eighth inches 119 0 1/8 her breadth Twenty three feet nine & one eighth inches 23 9 1/8 her depth Nine feet one & one eighth inches 9 1/8 and that she measures Two hundred & forty six tons Eighty three ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a single head.

And the said Thomas P. Folger having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this 15th day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty seven.
