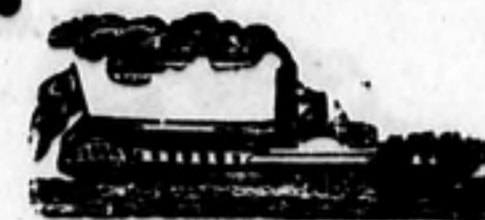


# ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with  
John Pease and Augustus Peter Thompson of the same  
place and John S. Lee and Chas. S. East of Troy  
N.Y.

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Propeller \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
California of Buffalo whereof Frederick W. McQuinn  
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New  
York \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 1846 as appears by His Enrollment  
dated at this Port the 1st day of May 1846 and  
numbered Ninety seven being charged owned  
And the said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that  
the said Propeller or vessel has Two decks and One mast and that her  
length is One hundred and sixty nine feet and five inches  
her breadth Twenty five feet and five inches  
her depth Ten feet and three inches  
and that she measured Four hundred twenty tons Twenty Six ninety-fifths  
that she is a Propeller has Register \_\_\_\_\_  
and \_\_\_\_\_ head.

And the said John L. Kimberly \_\_\_\_\_ having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.

in the said District, this Twenty first day of May  
in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty seven.
