

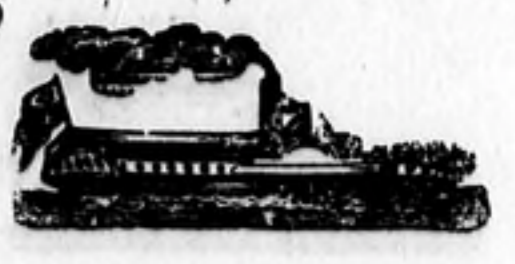

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Fredrick A. M. Knight of Buffalo N York  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the

Rocky Mountain whereof John M. Sandcut is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Port Piquin New York in the year 1843 as appears by New Enrollment

dated at the Port of Cleveland the 25th May 1846 Numbered Twenty five (25) and having changed name

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is twenty feet

her breadth twenty feet and six inches  
her depth eight feet and seven inches

and that she measures one hundred and forty seven tons forty eighths ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner has two galens and a screw head.

And the said Fredrick A. M. Knight having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this Twentieth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty seven
