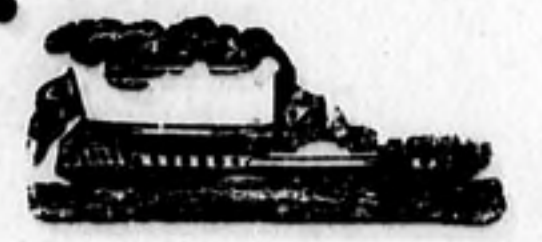

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Zachus Butler of Rensselaer County N.Y.
 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel called the
A. Balis whereof *Zachus Butler*
 is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn, is a
 Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Alamattit*
Alamattit in the year 1841 as appears by the certificate of
Zachus Butler dated the 28th day of May 1847, now on
 file in this office.

And *William J. Mack* Surveyor having certified that
 the said Canal Boat or vessel has *One deck* and *No Masts* and that her
 length is *Seventy eight feet* 78 ft
 her breadth *Fourteen feet* 14 "
 her depth *Four feet and four inches* 4 " 4 "
 and that she measures *Forty four* tons *forty two* ninety-fifths.
 that she is a Canal Boat has _____
 and _____ head.

And the said *Zachus Butler* having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
 mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at
 the Port of Buffalo Creek.

 in the said District, this *Twenty-fifth* day of *May*
 in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *seven*
