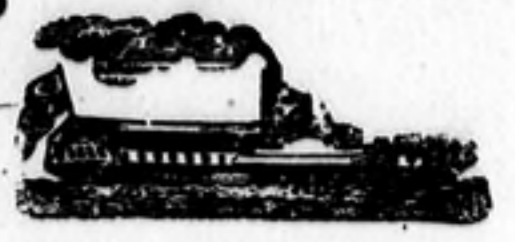

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Charles Y. Richmond of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together
with *Wm Richmond of the same place*

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the

Charles Y. Richmond whereof *Alfred Davis* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cleveland Ohio* in the year 1846 as appears by the Certificate

dated at the port of *Detroit* the *Twenty fourth* day of *April* 1846, numbered *115* fifth and hundred and *thirty* and the said Certificate having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One deck* and *two masts*, and that her length is *One hundred and nine feet and two inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet ten and 1/4 inches* her depth *Five feet and seven 1/4 inches* and that she measures *Two hundred twenty and four* tons fully furnished

that she is a Schooner has *No* gallery and head.

And the said *Charles Y. Richmond* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *Twenty seventh* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *forty seven*
