

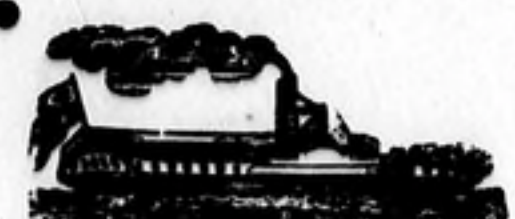

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Richard Seal of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with John W. Griffiths of the same place Sylvester F. Atwood of Michigan Alvin C. Wright and W. Henry Wright of all above City Ohio are

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the Onyiahoga whereof Sylvester F. Atwood is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Maumee City Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this Port the twenty fourth day of July 1846 and Numbered 48, Tons eight hundred having changed owner And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has two Masts and One Mast and that her length is One hundred & Eighty two feet and Six inches 182-6 her breadth Twenty seven feet and Six inches 27-6 her depth Eleven feet four and One half inches 11 1/2 and that she measures One hundred forty five tons fully beam ninety-fifths: that she is a Steam Boat has no galley and No head.

And the said Richard Seal having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this Fourth day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty.
