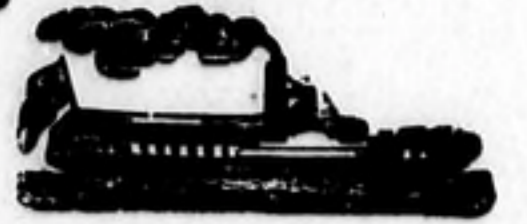

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

in the year 1835 as appears by *Her Enrollment*
dated at this port of *Cleveland* the *Eleventh* day of
April 1846 & numbered *181*, *New* surrounded *Heavy* *Chung* *Wound*
And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts, and that her
length is *Sixty five* feet and *Six* inches *65 ft 6 in*
her breadth *Nineteen* feet and *Six* inches *19 ft 6 in*
her depth *Seven* feet *7*
and that she measures *Seventy six* tons *fifty five* ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has *No* *gating* *to* *square* *stern*
and a *Spade* *head* *head*

And the said *Migron Sage* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek
in the said District, this *Fourth* day of *June*
in the year one thousand eight hundred and *forty*.
