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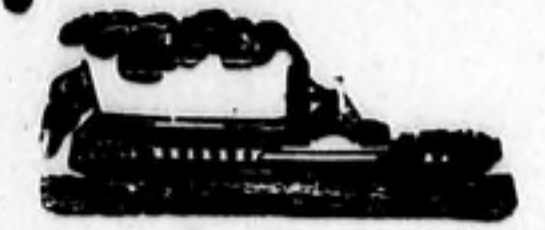

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is *jointly*  
with *Benjamin Hollister of Piquette Ohio*

**CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES**, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Robert W. Hollister Buffalo* whereof *Charles G. Kuhn* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Piquette Ohio* in the year 1847 as appears by the certificate of *Genl. G. Kuhn* Master builder dated this 8th day of *June* 1847. Now on file in this Office \_\_\_\_\_

and *William J. Linn* \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One deck* and *Two Masts*, and that her length is *One hundred and Ninety feet four inches* 119.04 her breadth *Twenty six feet* 26 her depth *Nine feet and seven inches* 19-7 and that she measures *Two hundred thirty two tons* Two hundred ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner has two Masts \_\_\_\_\_ Square Stern and a *Round* head.

And the said *John Hollister* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *Eighth* day of *June* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty. *Francis M. Stephens*
