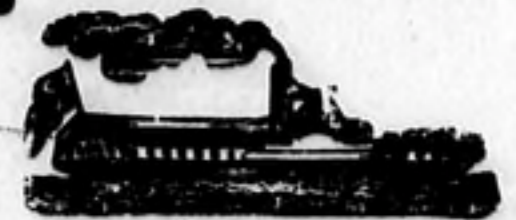

ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Anthony Van Duwagen of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel called the
"Main Point" whereof Chas. Wagoner is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Jefferson
New York in the year 1844 as appears by the Enrollment
of the Canal Boat "Main Point" dated at the Port of
New York June 6th 1846 and numbered having
And this said enrollment having certified that
the said Canal Boat vessel has One deck and No mast and that her
length is Seventy seven feet and four inches 77 ft 4
her breadth Fourteen feet and six inches 14 ft 6
her depth Five feet and three inches 5 ft 3
and that she measures Fifty four (54) tons ninety-fifths:
that she is a Canal Boat has a flat bottom
and No head.

And the said Anthony Van Duwagen having
agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.

in the said District, this 21st day of June
in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty.
