In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838;

John Peck of Buffalo Creek

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and as he hath sworn is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1842, as appears by the Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo the 17th day of May 1845 and numbered (N.V.) Twenty two and numbered having changed name

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Boston of Buffalo whereof ~~E. M. Bond~~ J. M. Bond is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1842, as appears by the Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo the 17th day of May 1845 and numbered (N.V.) Twenty two and numbered having changed name

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is Forty one feet and three inches her breadth Twenty three feet and three inches her depth Eight feet and one half inches and that she measures One hundred and fifty five tons and is a Brig and is secured

And the said John Peck having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
