In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Oswell Patterson of New York Administrator of the Estate of David F. B. Randall, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is, together with Frederick A. M. R. of Buffalo New York.

Summers At this port the 28th day of June 1848 having changed owner and new papers issued signed Chas W. H. R. and R. C. R.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Commodore Shannon, whereof Oswell Patterson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New York in the year 1843 as appears by New Enrollment dated at this Port the Twenty first day of April 1847, and Numbered (15) and Summers having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is Sixty four feet and one inch her breadth Nineteen feet and one inch her depth Seven feet and Seven inches and that she measures Eighty tons burthen ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has No galley and a Stern head

And the said Oswell Patterson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
