In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,  
Samuel Purdy of Buffalo New York;

having taken or subscribed the Oath, required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at  
City of Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by the certificate of  
Mr. James M. Matthews builder, dated the 15th day of  
September 1847. I now file in this office

Given of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the  
August Delmont whereof Jacob Leavelle  
is the present Master; and as he hath sworn  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at  
City of Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by the certificate of  
Mr. James M. Matthews builder, dated the 15th day of  
September 1847. I now file in this office

And the said Certificate having certified that  
the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two Masts and that  
her length is One hundred and twenty feet and Nine inches  
her breadth Twenty one feet and three inches  
her depth Eight feet Seven and one half inches  
and that she measures Two hundred and thirty four and ninety-fifths;  
that she is a Schooner and has

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
