In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838;

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Avenger whereof Joseph Cooper is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Joseph Cooper is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cott. Mott Mich. in the year 1845 as appears by How Enrollment dated at the Port of W. York on the first day of June 1846 and is Number 1397 was demised, having changed owner

And the Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two masts and that her length is Seventy one feet 41 feet her breadth Seventeen feet and eight inches 17 " 8 in her depth Eight feet and one inch 8 " 1 " and that she measures Seventy seven tons Seventy five ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has No gallery and Mr Scott head

And the said Merly R. Howard having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
