In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

Samuel Brown of Buffalo New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Geo A. Finch of the same place,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the General Post or Vessel, called the General Post whereof John A. Finch is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Albany New York in the year 1847 as appears by the Certificate of Peter

Wheaton Master-builder dated 19 July 1847 now on file in this office

And the said Peter Wheaton having certified that the said General Post or Vessel has One deck and that her length is seventy seven feet seven inches seven feet nine inches her breadth fourteen feet and four inches her depth four feet and five inches and that she measures forty six tons that she is a General Post has

And the said Samuel Brown having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said General Post has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
