In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled  
"An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February,  
1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern,  
Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,  
passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of  
passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833,

George B. Walbridge of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is  
together with Lewis M. Appleby of Cincinnati Ohio  
Joseph Lake & Benjamin Carpenter,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the  
Lucy A. Rogers whereof Lewis M. Appleby  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cincinnati  
Ohio in the year 1846 as appears by the Enrollment dated

at Hillport the thirtieth day of July 1846 and numbered  
44 fully from New Summers having changed owned.

And the said Enrollment having certified that  
the said Brig or Vessel has One No. 10 and Two Masts and that  
her length is One hundred and seven feet and four inches 117ft 4.  
her breadth Twenty five feet and Nine inches 24 - 9  
her depth Nine feet and eight inches 9 - 8  
and that she measures Two hundred and fifty eight tons Nine  
that she is a Brig has ninety-fifths;

And the said George B. Walbridge and a Clerk head  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been  
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly  
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
