New York in the year 1846 as appears by the certificate of the

Master builder W. W. Howd dated September 18, 1847 New
York in his Office
And the William J. Mack Surveyor having certified that
the said Canal Boat or Vessel has On Deck and
her length is Seventy eight feet and eight inches
her breadth Fourteen feet three inches
her depth Five feet and one inch
and that she measures Fifty three tons forty four ninety-fifths;
that she is a Canal Boat has

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
