In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Geo. B. Walbridge of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Big* or Vessel, called the *G. B. Walbridge of Buffalo*, whereof *David N. Hulston* is at present Master; and as he hath *David* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Wilmington, Ohio* in the year 1844, as appears by *How Enrollment dated*

at this port the *30th* day of August 1844 and Number 53. Fifty Two New Sun and *Passing Abandoned* owned.

And the said Enrollment *and* having certified that the said *Big* or Vessel has *One* and *Two* masts and that her length is *One hundred and four feet and six and a half inches* her breadth *Twenty four feet and two and a half inches* her depth *Nine feet and two and a half inches* and that she measures *Two hundred and twenty two tons* *Eighteen* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Big* has *No* gun and *and* and *head*

And the said *George B. Walbridge* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Big* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
