# ENROLLMENT.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

George B. Walbridge of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a  
Partner with Will B. Walbridge and John H. Blodgett,  
of Buffalo N.Y. and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel, called the  
**Diamond** ———— whereof Benjamin Frankenburg  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn ————  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo  
New York ———— in the year 1847 as appears by <sup>How Enrollment stated</sup>  
at this port the seventh day of May 1847, <sup>(5th)</sup> <sup>thirty</sup> <sup>four</sup>  
having changed owner ————

And the said Enrollment ———— having certified that  
the said Steam Boat or Vessel has One Deck and One Mast, and that  
her length is One hundred & fifty one feet ———— 1 51 feet  
her breadth Twenty four feet and six inches ———— 24 " 6 in  
her depth Nine feet and five inches ———— 9 " 5  
and that she measures Three hundred & thirty one tons One ———— ninety-fifths;  
that she is a Steam Boat ———— has ————  
——— at a Stern ———— head

And the said George B. Walbridge ———— having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been  
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly  
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
