In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838:

Frederick N. Jones of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and as he hath sworn together with Benjamin Bagwell, James M. Jones and Jasper Hodge of Buffalo N.Y. and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Novella whereof James M. Jones is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1848 as appears by the Certificate of Frederick

N. Jones Shipping Agent dated April 18th 1848 now on file in this Office

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Mast and two Masts and that her length is One hundred and twenty seven feet and seven inches 171 ft 7 in her breadth Twenty four feet and ten inches 24 ft 10 in her depth Nine feet four and three fourths inches 9 ft 11 3/4 in and that she measures Two hundred fifty five tons (Twenty nine ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig and a Scow head

And the said Frederick N. Jones having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
