In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Abraham Johnson of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Frederick Smith of Westport Vermont

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Wreck whereof Thomas P. Carter is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at St. Albans in the year 1842 as appears by his Enrollment dated

at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. Twelfth day of August 1847 and Number 89, Eighty nine - Now summoned having changed Owner And the said Enrollment

having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts, and that her length is Eighty feet and six inches 80. feet 6 in her breadth Twenty feet and four inches 20. 4. her depth Six feet and three inches 6. 11. and that she measures One hundred & five tons Tonnage ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no gallies

and head And the said Abraham Johnson having agreed to the description and appraisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
