In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833;

Jacob Ambow of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Partner with John F. Puter of St Joseph Michigan

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel, called the "Audubon" whereof Jacob Ambow is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1846 as appears by the Enrollment dated

at the Port of Cleveland Ohio dated the 14th September 1847 and numbered Twenty four (24) and amended having changed name And the said Enrollment having certified that

the said Steam Boat or Vessel has One Deck and One Mast and that her length is One hundred and four feet eight inches her breadth Thirty two feet her depth Twelve feet

and that she measures One hundred fifty tons forty six ninety-fifths; that she is a Steam Boat and has a Round Stern.

And the said Jacob Ambow and Mr. Puter head agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
