In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels, propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

Charles S. Gay of *Buffalo New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Steam Boat* or *Vessel*, called the *Albany* whereof *C. S. Gay* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Detroit Michigan* in the year 1846 as appears by *Her Enrollment* dated at the Port of *Detroit* 28th day of *July* 1846, and numbered *71* (Seventy One), *New Numbered* having *Changed* District

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Steam Boat* or *Vessel* has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her length is *Two hundred and two feet* 207 feet her breadth *Twenty nine feet* 29 feet her depth *Eleven feet and eight inches* 11' 8" and that she measures *Eighty six tons* thirty six ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat* has *One galley* and *One boiler* head

And the said *Charles S. Gay* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
