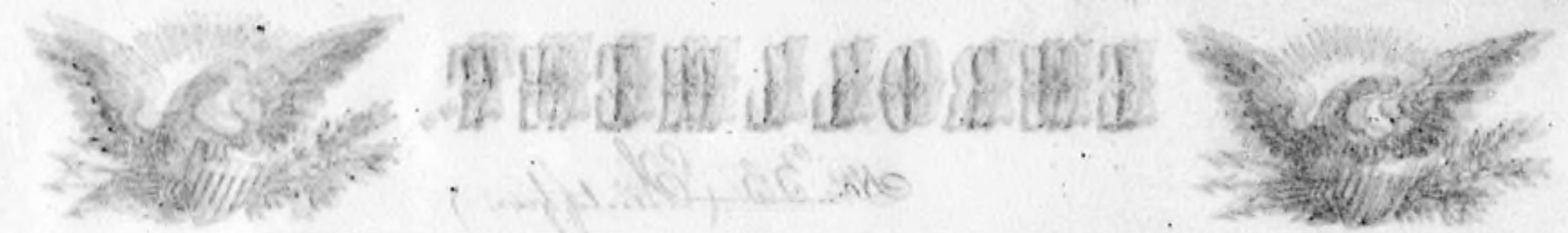
And the said Enrollment having certified that

given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
