the said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck, and One Mast and that
her length is One hundred and forty eight feet
her breadth Twenty four feet, six and one half inches
her depth Ten feet Nine and One fourth inches
and that she measures Three hundred thirty tons twenty nine

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
