In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

the said Brig or Vessel had One deck and Two masts, and that
her length is One hundred and fifteen feet, Two inches 115 ft 10 in
her breadth Twenty four Three and One half inches 24 ft 9 in
her depth Nine feet and five inches 9 ft 5 in
and that she measures Two hundred and forty eight tons One hundred and ninety-fifths;
that she is a Brig and head
And the said Amintor O. Davis having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
