In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Ralph Farnsworth, of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the St. Louis whereof Robert H. Miesenden is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sandusky City Ohio, in the year 1848 as appears by the Certificate of Vincent Biddle, Shipwright at Buffalo

And the said certificate having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts, and that her length is One hundred and thirteen feet and eight inches, 113 ft 8 in her breadth Twenty four feet and two inches 24 ft 2 in her depth Eight feet and two inches 8 ft 2 in and that she measures Two hundred and ten, tons eighty ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig and a Beroll head

And the said Ralph Farnsworth having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
