In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c.; passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck, and Two Masts, and that her length is One hundred and fifteen feet and three inches - 115 ft - 3 in her breadth Twenty five feet, and four inches - 25 ft - 4 in her depth Nine feet four and a half inches - 9 ft - 4 1/2 in and that she measures Two hundred and fifty tons Tons ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner and a screw head

And the said William O. Brown having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, New York
