In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

George Voit of Buffalo New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Henry R. Seymour whereof John P. Davidson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn John P. Davidson is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Three Mile Bay Jefferson Co N.Y. in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this port the twenty sixth day of November 1847, Number (144) One hundred forty four, now amended having changed name and the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts, and that her length is One hundred and twenty five feet and three inches 119 ft. 3 in her breadth Twenty four feet and nine inches 24 ft. 9 in her depth Nine feet One and a half inches 9 ft. 1 1/2 in and that she measures Two hundred forty five tons Eighty Eight in ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig and a Scow head

And the said George Voit having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
