In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1821; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Thomas P. Folger of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is
together with Robert Kyle of Buffalo N.Y. and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the
St Louis - 20 whereof Robert Kyle
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Kalamazoo
Michigan in the year 1843 as appears by her last Enrollment
dated the twenty second day of May, 1848, which had
been lost at sea by the Oath of Robert Kyle now on file
in this Office

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said - Brig or Vessel has One No. 10 and two small, and that
her length is Ninety seven feet and six inches - 97 ft 6 in
her breadth Twenty three feet and eleven inches - 23 ft 11 in
her depth Eight feet two and a half inches - 8 ft 2 1/2 in
and that she measures One hundred & eighty five tons seventy four - 185 tons 74 lbs
that she is a Brig - and a screw head

And the said Thomas P. Folger having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
