In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

E. R. Rogus. J. C. Walter of Chicago Illinois

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the
Robert Hollister whereof Nelson W. Mascher
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Poughkeepsie
Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by the Enrollment dated

at that port June 8th 1847, Number Sixty two, 62, now summed having
changed named and altered to a Brig
And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Brig or Vessel has One Mast and two Masts and that
her length is One hundred and thirty two feet and four inches 119 feet,
her breadth Twenty six feet 26 " "
her depth Nine feet and seven inches 9 " 7 "
and that she measures Two hundred Twenty two tons Seven ninety-fifths;
that she is a Brig has

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, C. N.
