In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Samuel L. Hastings of Springfield Massachusetts and Robert Brighton of Cleveland Ohio and Thomas Fitzpatrick of Buffalo N.Y.

are Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller or Vessel, called the General Taylor of Buffalo whereof the said Asa E. Hart is at present Master; and as he hath

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N. York in the year 1847 as appears by the Certificate of J. N. Jones Shipwright dated at this Port October 4th 1848. now on file in this Office

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is one Hundred & Seventy two feet & eight inches 172 ft. 8 in her breadth Twenty five feet & eight inches 25 .. 8 .. her depth Ten feet ten & three fourths inches 10 .. 10 3/4 .. and that she measures Four Hundred Sixty two & one ninth tons Ninety One -- ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller -- has

and a figure-head And the said Asa E. Hart -- having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
