In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Blue Bell whereof Nathan S. Mead is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Warren Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by New Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo October 3^d 1845. and Merrimack, forty six (46) Now presented having changed owner.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Ninety feet and six inches 90 feet six her breadth Twenty two feet and two inches 22 " 2. her depth Eight feet and four inches 8 " 4. and that she measures One hundred fifty tons Septem ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has

and a Screw head And the said Nathan S. Mead having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
