In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833,  
William O. Brown of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a  
Master and Commander of the said Ship or Vessel

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the  
Ming and Ring whereof Charles Clark  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland,  
Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by the enrollment dated

at the Port of Cleveland Ohio Decemr 14th 1847 Number 90 Ninety Nine  
Schooner having changed Owner  
And the said enrollment having certified that  
the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts, and that  
her length is One hundred and thirty three inches 106 ft. 3 in  
her breadth Twenty three feet eight inches 23 " 8 "  
her depth Nine feet five and a half inches 9 " 5 1/2 "  
and that she measures Two hundred and fifteen tons eighty four ninety-fifths;  
that she is a Schooner has

an eagle pennant  
And the said William O. Brown having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been  
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly  
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
