In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

Henry P. Darroin of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel, called the *George Davis* whereof *Louis F. Gray* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1846 as appears by her Enrollment

dated at this Port April 16th 1847 & numbered fourteen (14) now surrendered having changed owners And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is One hundred seven feet & three inches 111 ft 3 inches her breadth Twenty three feet & nine inches 23 ft 9 inches her depth Nine feet & ten inches 9 ft 10 inches and that she measures two hundred thirty eight tons forty six ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has and a scroll head

And the said Henry P. Darroin having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
