In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry P. Darrow of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Cyrus C. Bristol of Buffalo N.Y. Henry C. Walker and Isaac C. Walker of Milan Ohio

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Magnolia

whereof Samuel Wood is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by a certified copy of her last Enrollment, her Enrollment having been lost as appears by the Oath of Henry C. Walker, which Enrollment was dated April 2nd 1846 numbered three (3), at the Port of Sandusky, having changed owner

And the P. Certificate of Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Ninety five feet or five inches 95 ft 5 in her breadth twenty three feet four or one half inches 23, 4 1/2 her depth nine feet or eleven inches 9, 11 and that she measures one hundred ninety eight tons sixty seven ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has a square Stern and a Scroll head

And the said Henry P. Darrow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
