In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c.; passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Aaron O. Patchin of Buffalo New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel, called the A. O. Patchin whereof Wm Whitaker is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Torraco Michigan in the year 1846 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this port October 2^d 1846 and Number (64) Sixty four Now she is having changed Owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steam Boat or Vessel has One Mast and ten Oars and that her length is two hundred and twenty five feet and seven inches her breadth Twenty Nine feet her depth Thirteen feet and Nine inches and that she measures Eight Hundred thirty three tons twenty eight and that she is a Steam Boat and a Scull head

And the said Aaron O. Patchin having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
