In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

Robert Montgomery of Buffalo, N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Detroit Michigan in the year 1845 as appears by his Enrollment dated at this port the twentieth day of November 1847, & numbered one hundred & forty two (142) tons surrendered having changed owners.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller or Vessel, called the Detroit whereof Robert Montgomery is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Detroit Michigan in the year 1845 as appears by his Enrollment dated at this port the twentieth day of November 1847, & numbered one hundred & forty two (142) tons surrendered having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is One hundred & twenty eight feet & six inches 128 ft. 6. inches her breadth Twenty five feet 25 " her depth Three feet ten inches 3 ft. 10. " and that she measures One hundred & thirty three tons twenty one ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller has and head

And the said Robert Montgomery having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
