In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Walter Fay of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by

his Enrollment dated at the Port of Sandusky dated 17th April 1848. and numbered (6) Ship now surrendered having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is One Hundred and four feet and eight inches 104. ft 8 in her breadth Twenty three feet and one inch 23 " 1 " her depth Eight feet Three and one half inches 8 " 3/2 " and that she measures One hundred & Eighty four tons Seventeen ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig has no Gallies and a Scull head

And the said Walter Fay agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
