 her length is *Sixty one* feet and *five* inches
 her breadth *Twenty* feet and *two* inches
 her depth *Seven* feet and *five* inches
 and that she measures *Ninety Six* tons *Thirty Six* ninety-fifths;
 that she is a Schooner has *no* Gallies and has a figure head
 head

And the said (William Chard) having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
