Asstn Surveyor and Samuel F. Lester of Cleveland Ohio

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the W. B. Spaulding

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1849 as appears by the certificate of Medrick

St. James Shipwright dated the 25th April 1849, now on file in this Office

And the said certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck and One Mast and that her length is One hundred fifty two feet and four inches 152 ft 4 in her breadth Seventy five feet and two inches 75 " 2 in her depth Eleven feet six and one half inches 11 " 6 1/2 in and that she measures four hundred & fifteen tons fifty six ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller has

And the said James W. Evans and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
