In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry Roof of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the *Paradise Prichard* whereof *Joseph E. New* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *New Ohio* in the year 1847 as appears by Her Enrollment dated

at New York November 6th 1847 and Numbered 139 One hundred thirty nine, now decreed having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Mast* and two masts and that her length is *One hundred & seven feet* 107 feet her breadth *Twenty four feet & three inches* 24 " 3in her depth *Eight feet and four inches* 8 " 4in and that she measures *One hundred thirty six tons* sixty three ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner

And the said *Henry Roof* and a crew head agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
