In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Mayor A. Campbell of Buffalo N. York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Fall Trade whereof John Hale

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cape Vincent New York in the year 1834 as appears by An Enrollment dated at this Port September 9th 1847, and Numbered Twenty five (25) now amended having been rebuilt and enlarged at Buffalo in the year 1849.

And William J. Leach Surgeon having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is Seventy eight feet 48 feet her breadth Twenty one feet and two inches 21 " her depth Eight feet six and one half inches 8 " and that she measures One hundred twenty four Twenty six ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner and has a Square Stern head

And the said Mayor A. Campbell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
