In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Willard W. Bingham of New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Horatio N. Barnham of Silver Creek and Justin Clark of Silver Creek - New York

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Commodore Chauncey whereof Willard W. Bingham is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Siler Creek New York in the year 1843 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this Port the 21st day of July 1847 & amended by Minute (79) Now amended having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Mast and two masts and that her length is Sixty four feet four inches 64 ft 4 in her breadth Fifteen feet four inches 15 ft 4 in her depth Seven feet and seven inches 7 ft 7 in and that she measures Eighty tons Seventeen ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no galley and a single head

And the said Willard W. Bingham having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
