In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the *Henry Day* whereof *Aaron Root* is at present Master; and he hath sworn *Ohio* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Milan Ohio* in the year *1849* as appears by the certificate of

Aaron Root of Berlin Ohio, *Superintendent* dated at this port *19th May 1849* now on file in this office

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has *One Mast* and *One Deck* and that her length is *One hundred seven feet six inches* — *107 ft 6 in* her breadth *Twenty two feet, seven and one half inches* — *22 ft 7 1/2 in* her depth *Nine feet and eleven inches* — *9 ft 11 in* and that she measures *Two hundred twenty one tons* *Twenty eight* *ninety-fifths*; that she is a Propeller *has*

And the said *George M Hook* and *head* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
