In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steamboat or Vessel, called the **Wharton** whereof is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at **Yonon** in the year 1849 as appears by the certificate of **Frederick W. Richardson** of **Sturm Chic. Shipwright** dated at this port June 1st 1849 then on file in this Office

And the **W. J. Mack** Surveyor having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has **One Deck** and **One Mast** and that her length is **One hundred and thirty one feet** and **Eleven inches** her breadth **Twenty feet** and **two three fourths inches** her depth **Seven feet** and **nine inches** and that she measures **One hundred thirty four tons** **Sixty four** ninety-fifths; that she is a **Steam Boat** has

And the said Shipman **P. Turner** and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamboat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
