And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is Eighty two feet Six inches her breadth Twenty three feet Six inches her depth Eight feet Six inches and that she measures one hundred forty four tons Three ninety-fifths, that she is a Schooner has

and a small head And the said George B. Walbridge having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
