In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Benjamin F. Bruce of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the *Lucile Tom* whereof Benjamin F. Bruce is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at St. Clair Michigan in the year 1842. as appears by

the Enrollment dated at this Port April 12th 1849. number twenty five, (25) now surrendered having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is eighty feet six inches her breadth Twenty feet four inches her depth Six feet and eleven inches and that she measures one hundred & ten tons fourteen ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has no gallies

And the said Benjamin F. Bruce having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
