In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a Register with Samuel F. Holston of Black Rock New York, Alexander M. Shelby, Arthur Knappell and S. H. Latta, of Cleveland Ohio, and William C. Evans of Buffalo, New York

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Clarendon or Vessel, called the Clarendon whereof Erasmus Prudden is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1848 as appears by Log-Enrollment dated

at this Port, May 15th 1848, and Numbered 34 of the New York Vessel having changed Owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck and One Mast and that her length is One hundred and forty eight feet — 118 ft her breadth Twenty four feet six and one half inches — 24 ft 6 1/2 her depth Ten feet nine and one fourth inches — 10 ft 9 1/4 and that she measures Three hundred twenty nine and ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller

And the said James C. Evans and Erasmus Prudden head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
