In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

George W. Holt of Buffalo, New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Charles J. Polger of Geneva New York and Robert Kyle of Buffalo New York are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Brig or Vessel, called the St Louis 2<sup>nd</sup> whereof Robert Kyle is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Kalamazoo Michigan in the year 1843 as appears by her last enrollment dated the seventeenth day of August 1848 now amended and having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is Ninety seven feet and Six inches 97 ft 6 in her breadth Thirty three feet & Eleven inches 33 ft 11 in her depth Eight feet Ten and a half 8 ft 10 1/2 and that she measures One hundred eighty five tons seventy four ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig has no gallies and a scroll

And the said George W. Holt head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
